## I. Elmo Rice Krispie Treats



## Ingredients:

- Kellogg's Rice Krispie Treats
- Red Food Coloring or any type of red food dye
- Orange Reese's Piece Candy or Orange M&M's
- Oreo Cookies
- Candy Eyeballs or Bright White Candy Melts
- Black Decorating Icing



- 1. Take your Rice Krispie Treat and cover it completely in red food coloring or red food dye.
- 2. To make the Elmo Face, start with two candy eyeballs (or bright white candy melts).
- 3. You will use black decorating icing as your "glue" by squeezing two dabs of black icing at the top of your Rice Krispie Treat while it is lying flat.

- 4. Press your candy eyeballs directly on top of your dabs of black icing. If you are using bright white candy melts, you will need to squeeze one small dab of black icing in the center of your candy melts for his pupils.
- 5. For Elmo's nose, you will place a small dab of black icing in the middle of the Rice Krispie Treat for his nose. Then press your orange Reese's piece or M&M on top of this black dab.
- 6. For Elmo's mouth, break in half an Oreo cookie. Take the one-half of the chocolate wafer from the Oreo cookie and place it squarely underneath Elmo's "orange nose". If you choose the part of the chocolate wafer that has no icing, you will need to use the black icing as glue again. If your chocolate wafer piece has icing on it, you may place the wafer with the icing side down onto your Rice Krispie Treat without black icing. If your Oreo piece is too big for the face, try nibbling it down until you get it to the right size.
