Opening HeinOnline

Double-click the “Hein Online” Icon on the desktop.



Or


HeinOnline App

If you are using the app, download the app from the Apple Store by searching for “HeinOnline,” click on “Install.” Once Downloaded, open the app and select the “IP Authentication Box.”



Narrowing Results

Narrow results by selecting the collection, document type, or date on the left hand side.



Keyword Searching

You can search by keyword by simply typing a word or phrase into the basic search box. Then single-click the  icon.



Case Searching

Search by citation by clicking on the “Case Law” tab. Enter the citation a single-click the  icon.

Browse by single-clicking on any of the following:

Search for an article by blue book citation by clicking on the citation tab. Enter the citation a single-click the  icon.





Advanced Searching and Document Retrieval

Advanced Searching

Advanced search will allow you to search multiple fields including Title, Author, Keyword (Full Text), and Date. Single-click on “Advanced Search” and the search screen will appear.
