General Guidelines:

- ✓ The contest is open to any person 18 years or older.
- ✓ Writers may enter one original short story.
- ✓ The story must have 1000 to 2500 words total in a pdf or word document.
- ✓ Stories should be suitable for a general audience.
- ✓ Previously published stories will not be accepted.
- ✓ Submission must be received by the deadline, December 31 2020.

Submitting Your Story

1. Write your story using the writer's prompt in a word document.
2. Save your story in a Word document or in a plain text file.
3. Attach a cover page that include title and your name.
4. E-mail title must include: story title and the "Writer's Challenge." (Example: The Stand/Writer's Challenge)
5. Submit your story by email to Asia Brown at mcpublic@fortbend.lib.tx.us.
6. Writers will receive a confirmation upon submission.

We cannot switch versions of your story if you've changed something after submission. Unless specified upon submission, accepted stories will be published on Missouri City Branch Library Facebook page on Wednesday, January 6, 2021.
